MEMBER/VENDOR TOMBSTONE AND KARTCHNER CAVERNS TOUR

On Tuesday morning, June 12th, you'll have the opportunity to tour Tombstone, Az and the Kartchner Caverns.

Tour of Tombstone and Kartchner Caverns

Tombstone is like taking a trip back to the Old West. Called by some "The West's Most Famous Town," Tombstone, Arizona, was founded in 1877 when word spread of a silver strike.

The famous Gunfight at the OK Corral occurred in Tombstone in 1881. At its peak the town's population was estimated between 15 and 20 thousand people with more than one hundred saloons, many restaurants, schools, churches and one of the first public swimming pools in Arizona. (It's still used today.)

Kartchner Caverns State Park Rotunda Tour. This tour is a half of a mile in length and takes approximately an hour and a half to complete, 50 minutes of which is underground. Discover the role that water plays in creating the caverns. You will see the discoverers' original trail, 45,000-year-old bat guano, delicate formations and "Kubla Khan," the largest column formation in Arizona.

The cost is \$125 per person and includes lunch.
